

Job Description: Outreach Team Volunteer

Overview

Outhouse LGBTQ+ Centre has been a cornerstone of support, connection, and advocacy for Dublin's queer community for almost three decades. An Outreach Volunteer at Outhouse will play a vital role in engaging with the public during Pride events to raise awareness about Outhouse's mission. Volunteers will distribute leaflets, solicit donations along the parade route, and communicate Outhouse's work to those unfamiliar with it.

Key Responsibilities and Duties

Public Engagement and Awareness

- Distribute leaflets and engage the public along the parade route.
- Clearly communicate Outhouse's mission to individuals who may not be familiar with the organisation.
- Solicit donations and encourage support for Outhouse's initiatives.

Fundraising and Advocacy

- Approach and interact with diverse groups to raise awareness.
- Promote Outhouse's work and encourage public involvement.
- Handle donations responsibly and maintain a positive, professional demeanour.

Event Support and Crowd Management

- Remain calm and composed under pressure, even if provoked.
- Navigate and operate effectively in a high-energy, crowded environment.

Functional Competencies

Essential

- Sociable and enthusiastic personality with confidence in public speaking.
- Ability to approach and interact with diverse groups.
- Comfort with fundraising and handling public engagement.
- Physical stamina to remain active throughout the event.
- Ability to remain calm under pressure and in overwhelming environments.

Desirable

- Previous experience in advocacy, fundraising, or event support.
- Familiarity with Outhouse's mission and LGBTQ+ community needs.

- 4. Volunteer Interviews** – If selected, you'll be invited to a short interview between *Tuesday, 22 April – Friday, 25 April*. We'll offer time slots during the day and early evening for flexibility.
- 5. Attend Volunteer Training** – To ensure all volunteers are fully prepared, everyone must attend our Volunteer Training Day on ***Saturday, 10 May***. This session will equip you with everything you need to confidently support our events and community.
