## Key Responsibilities and Duties

### Event Support

- Run fundraising activities and encourage donations.

### Patron Engagement

- Approach and interact with event attendees in a friendly, supportive manner.
- Provide guidance on event proceedings and available services.
- Promote Outhouse's mission and encourage community involvement.

## Logistics and Fundraising

- Manage basic cash handling and sales activities for fundraising.
- Ensure that all promotional materials and fundraising items are well-stocked and displayed properly.

- 5. Attend Volunteer Training** – To ensure all volunteers are fully prepared, everyone must attend our Volunteer Training Day on ***Saturday, 10 May***. This session will equip you with everything you need to confidently support our events and community.
